A Stellar explains how Criminon was a vital part of his successful reintegration.

This guarter we are sharing the testimony of Justin F., a Stellar Student who is about to leave work release and return to society after 15 years of incarceration:

"Criminon not only gave me the tools to succeed behind the fence, but prepared me to reintegrate into the community.

"If you think drug use and the temptation to make fast money is strong on the inside, you won't believe how great it is at work release. Unfortunately, I have seen many people fall. They have no selfcontrol and no guiding morals to get them through. Many are sent back to prison. Some leave here with a full-blown addiction.

"If it weren't for the knowledge and life skills that I learned on the Criminon program, I too would have

fallen victim. It saved me from falling into a black hole of despair and failure.

"It also taught me to always do my best, regardless of the situation, and helped me develop a strong

work ethic. During my nine months here, I gave one hundred percent to the job I was hired to do, showing up every day, on time, and performing to the best of my ability. I have paid off my restitution and am leaving with a nice amount to buy a vehicle. I am a new man with a plan.

"Thank you for helping me become the successful person I became at work release. I have learned to live again and be a productive, responsible citizen.

"Behind the fence, at work release, or in the real world - great things will come your way if you follow the Criminon path. It's all up to you."



THE WAY TO HAPPINESS HOW TO PLAY

The name of the game is getting new students onto and using the precepts of *The Way to Happiness* distance learning course. It's a win-win situation. You win, the students you enroll win, and others in your institution win too. YOU can make a difference in someone else's life!

- Signing up students is the first step. Choose people you think are ready for a change. Tell them about how much your life has changed since you started on the Criminon program, and in particular your wins from *The Way to Happiness* Course. Do they want changes in their life too?
- Give him/her one of the enclosed yellow course request cards. They can also write a letter requesting the course. A new student must be the one requesting to start *The Way to Happiness* Course. You cannot fill out a card and request it for him or her. **Remember, only give out yellow cards to NEW students, NOT to those already on the program.**
- Follow up with this person to make sure they received *The Way to Happiness* book and course materials. Make sure they are doing the lessons and sending them in. Completing the course is what we are going for, so they can apply the material to change their lives. Some may need extra help understanding the material. Many need reminders of how valuable the course is, and how important it is to keep sending their lessons in.

- Once we receive a request card or letter with your name on the referred-by line, you get 15 points for a sign-up. The office then sends materials out to your student. When their first lessons come into the office, you get another 35 points and when they complete the course, you get 50 points for a total of 100 for each student who completes.
- All your referred students and earned points are tracked and reported each quarter. There is no carry over from one quarter to another. Everyone starts the game with zero points at the start of a quarter.
- When 3 or more students you refer send in their first lesson, you will receive a commendation from Alison at the end of the quarter.
- When you need more yellow cards, just write to Alison and ask for more. They are easy to hand out to others who fill them out and just drop them in the mail. Be sure to put your name on the bottom line (referred by). If you can't use the cards, ask your librarian or chaplain if you can put them out for others to pick up, or if you can post them on a bulletin board. YELLOW CARDS ARE FOR SIGNING UP NEW STUDENTS ONLY.
